Presented by Éloize Expo, a new division of Cirque Éloize, this captivating and education exhibition will take visitors on a totally unique adventure with *Mario Cyr*, one of the most celebrated figures in the film and wildlife documentary industry, through breathtaking photos and videos.

Below the Ice with Mario Cyr will be presented **from June 2 to October 31, 2021** by appointment at Éloize Studios in Old Montreal.

For a long time now, I've wanted to share our unique space, housed in the former Dalhousie Station, with the general public, and to diversify our cultural offering. Over the past year our touring shows have either been postponed or cancelled. With our creative and production teams grounded here in Montreal, it was the perfect opportunity for us to develop a unique artistic concept and to launch our new division, Éloize Expo.

Our first ever exhibition, Below the Ice with Mario Cyr, is totally aligned with Cirque Éloize's mission to offer unique and meaningful entertainment. With this immersive exhibition, visitors will be transported by the beauty of the landscapes and the breathtaking images captured by Mario Cyr, a Magdalen Islander like myself who's passionate about preserving the delicate balance between humans and nature. Visitors will feel like they're accompanying him on one of his dives to discover the Arctic's marine and wildlife. Visitors will be captivated by the spectacular landscapes of the Canadian Arctic during this unforgettable exhibition, which culminates in a virtual dive with **Mario Cyr** thanks to a 360-degree projection space covered by an ice ceiling. Cross paths with spectacular iceberg gardens, polar bears, walruses, narwhals, sea angels and large marine animals. You'll also discover the expedition's base camp, the diving equipment, the challenges faced by the expedition team and much more!

Mario Cyr, one of the world's greatest marine explorers

Mario Cyr is a world-renowned reference in the film and wildlife documentary field. As an underwater cinematographer, he's collaborated on more than 150 productions including those for Disney Productions, Imax 3D, BBC, NHK, TV Tokyo, The Explorers, France 2, David Suzuki, National Geographic and The Cousteau Society. His long career and passion for marine life have led him to discover the world's seas, meeting the most admired and enigmatic animals on our planet along the way.

Mario Cyr is one of the few underwater filmmakers and photographers to film below the ice. His numerous missions have mostly taken place in colder regions, in the Arctic and Antarctic, allowing him to develop a deep knowledge and understanding of these polar environments, and to experience the upheaval they're facing today.
